Gertie Mai has held program coordination and management positions with the Ontario Federation of Indian Friendship Centres, Assembly of First Nations, Anishnawbe Health Toronto and Weeneebayko Area Health Authority. She has also worked with Ontario government agencies to develop Indigenous health strategies and initiatives. Her work has led to improved health research, policy, programs, service design and cross cultural/jurisdictional relationship management.
