

Announcement - Dr. David Borenstein, MD, CCFP (EM)

Following a competitive process, it is our great pleasure to announce Dr. David Borenstein as the successful candidate in the role of the Central East Local Health Integration Network (Central East LHIN) Clinical Quality Lead. In his new role, Dr. Borenstein will have the opportunity to influence change that results in improved patient outcomes, and experience of care. The ultimate goal will be to align the quality agenda while engaging the Central East LHIN communities to build on and help accelerate existing efforts to promote a culture of quality.

Dr. Borenstein is currently The Scarborough and Rouge Hospital's Emergency Department Director of Quality Improvement. His main focus of interest is on standardization of practice patterns and safe efficiency measures to reduce error and enhance patient care and experience. He is also a member of the License Appeal Tribunal of Ontario for the Ministry of the Attorney General and Clinical Lecturer in the University of Toronto's Faculty of Medicine, Department of Community and Family Medicine.
