


More people in Ontario are filling prescriptions for stronger opioids.

Commonly prescribed opioids and their strength: (approximiate morphine equilvalent)*




Percentage of change in opioid prescriptions filled from 2013/14 to 2015/16:

The number of opioids prescriptions filled in Ontario has increased in the last three years.



Prescriptions are up by nearly 450,000 since 2013/14.

*Strength does not factor in the dose, nor the length of the prescription. These levels are approximations only *Varies depending on patch strength and length of time on skin


